✓ Is it the same thing as politics? After all, isn't all politics social?



EMOTIONAL INTELLIGENCE



The ability to identify, assess, and manage the personal emotions of yourself and other people, as well as the collective emotions of groups of people.



- An understanding of your emotions
- Ability to control emotions and impulses

EMOTIONAL INTELLIGENCE



Focus & Reframe

- ✓ Emotions don't stay at home just because we are going to work
- Need to understand and manage emotions to make the most of each day
- ✓ Decades of research shows that EQ predicts success on the job over any other skill, including IQ and technical expertise




EMOTIONAL INTELLIGENCE: SURVIVOR TIP

What do you think of when you think about negotiations?




NEGOTIATIONS



Getting to yes, most times

- 1. Understand the politics
- 2. Be in tune with the emotions of the situation
- 3. Wants vs. Needs
- 4. Focus on common interests and objectives
- 5. Reach agreement
- 6. Repeat steps 1-5



NEGOTIATIONS



Focus & Reframe

- Recognize the type of negotiations you are in
- ✓ Trade things of unequal value
- ✓ Sometimes negotiating "no"



NEGOTIATIONS: "No" Sandwich



(Yes to the reason) - "I appreciate the opportunity to work with you on this project. My goal in this is to make sure my time is best spent and unfortunately...

(The no) for that fee, it's a little bit below than what I can accept at this time.

So because of that, I'm going to have to turn this opportunity down.

(Close with yes) However, please keep me in mind for other opportunities and please let me know how I can continue to support the organization."

NEGOTIATIONS: SURVIVOR TIP



Negotiations at work is more than a one-time transaction. You can have multiple encounters with the same person...Sometimes you have to give the other person a win
