PPPs: Partnership?

- Contractual arrangements: private sector partners funding & delivering public services
- Using partnership language but mainly transactional
- Normally limited collaboration or partnership with end users



Project Management: Some critical questioning

- Are project sponsors prioritized over end users?
- Do project stakeholders have limited agency?
 (lack of skill sets, power, resources, etc.)
- How can contracts promote collaboration with all interested stakeholders?
- Why does the language of project management assume a capitalist construct?

but to society's challenges in general."




